

Rainbow Corner Fall 2020 Information

Tuition/Supply Fees: Tuition will be collected month to month only.

- September Tuition will be due September 1st and late after September 10th
T/Th pro-rated September tuition will be \$90.00
T/W/Th pro-rated September tuition will be \$135.00
- Supply Fees will be due by September 10th
2 day/week supply fee = \$150
3 day/week supply fee = \$175
- October tuition will be due October 1st and late after October 10th
2 day/week = \$235 3 day/week = \$335
- September tuition checks may be dropped off in person beginning August 24th in the tower entrance, just inside the vestibule between the hours of 10:00-4:00 M-F. You may place them inside the Rainbow Corner Box.
- While we do not have the option to set up an automatic draft payment, you may set up online bill payments through your bank to have checks mailed directly to Rainbow Corner Preschool. Contact your bank to learn more about this. Be sure to place your child's name in the "memo".
- Credit Card payments will be taken over the phone September 8th-10th between 12:30-2:30

Admission Forms/Paperwork: Due by Thursday, September 10th

- Admission forms, health statement, handbook acknowledgement form, and immunization records will be due by Thursday, September 10th
- If you have a health statement on file with us, you do not need another one
- Paperwork may be dropped off in person beginning August 24th in the tower entrance, just inside the vestibule between the hours of 10:00-4:00 M-F. You may place them inside the Rainbow Corner box.

Class Sizes: Class sizes have been reduced for the reopening of Rainbow Corner. We will still have two teachers per class. These may be reassessed for the spring if our enrollment increases. Currently we have roughly 50% of our students returning.

- Two year old classes will have 6-8 students
- Three year old classes will have 8-10 students
- PreK classes will have 12-14 students

Safety Measures/Protocols:

- Reduced class sizes
- Adults and staff will wear masks and/or face shields while indoors and outdoors if 6' or closer to a student.
- Enhanced cleaning schedule during the day

- Deep cleaning each night with an electrostatic sprayer
- No Music and Movement classes for the fall to minimize cross exposure between classes
- No rest time for older PreK classes (allows for classes with more students to not have to place students so close together for rest time)
- One class at a time on the playground
- Increased time spent outdoors between recess and new outdoor classroom
- Screening and temperature checks at drop-off each morning
- Staff screenings & temperature checks will occur before each work-day
- RC Staff will serve as subs on their “non-scheduled” days to avoid bringing in excess personnel
- Shared community toys cleaned in between each class use
- Chapel schedule altered to accommodate fewer classes at a time in the Sanctuary w/ everyone spread out. No singing for now.
- Students will have their own supply boxes with crayons, scissors, glue sticks, etc.
- Students will store all personal items in their own cubbies such as backpacks, lunches, etc. We will not store lunch boxes side by side or in tubs.
- Toys that have been in student mouths will be placed in a tub with soapy water for cleaning before returned for classroom use.
- Fabric toys will not be utilized at this time.
- Students that become ill while at school will be removed from their class and made comfortable until a parent can pick them up. Students must be picked up within an hour. If needed, and possible, remaining students in class will relocate while the room is cleaned.
- Students/Staff that are exposed to someone that has tested positive for Covid-19 will have to self-isolate for 14 days from the point of exposure.
- Students or staff that test positive for Covid-19 will have to quarantine for 14 days from the date of the test or longer if symptoms persist. In some cases, a doctor’s note may be needed to return to school.
- Positive Covid-19 cases at Rainbow Corner will follow the guidelines below
 - Call county Health department to report and follow their instructions
 - Notify families
 - Deep clean rooms and common areas
 - Possibility that the school will have to close for a day or two depending on Health department recommendations
 - Anyone exposed to the person testing positive will have to self-isolate for 14 days from the point of contact

Regular and Routine Safety Guidelines as Regulated by Licensing Minimum Standards:
